The **Sonographer** participates directly inpatient care and is responsible for the care and comfort of the patient during any diagnostic sonogram. Operates ultrasound equipment to produce images of the body for diagnostic purposes and for providing accurate documentation of diagnostic images for the radiologist to interpret.
